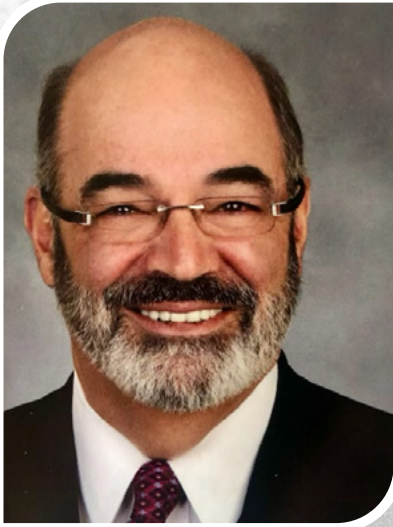

JOSEPH M. WINSTON COMMUNITY COMMITMENT AWARD HONOREE

Michael J. Falbo was president of the University of Wisconsin System Board of Regents from 2013-2015 and appointed to the Board of Regents in 2004. He served as interim president of the Universities of Wisconsin in 2022.

Mike's leadership and advocacy spans more than four decades. He began his career in banking as an auditor in 1973. By 1983 Mike was named the president and CEO of State Bank Hales Corners. Under his leadership, the company successfully integrated numerous acquisitions, growing total assets from \$75 million and 70 employees to 432 employees. Through careful strategic planning, he orchestrated growth of the company in a very competitive industry through challenging economic times.

Mike served as chairman and CEO of TierOne Bank based in Lincoln, Neb. TierOne Corporation is the parent company of TierOne Bank, a \$3.1 billion federally chartered savings bank and the largest publicly traded financial institution headquartered in Nebraska.

Mike was previously chairman of Associated Bank Community Development, LLC, an affiliate of Associate Banc Corp. He is the former chairman and CEO of State Financial Services Corporation, a \$1.5 billion financial services company that was based in Milwaukee, with operations in Wisconsin and Illinois. The company was the fifth-largest bank holding company in the state and was publicly traded on the Nasdaq National Market System.

Mike served in the United States Army and completed a tour in Vietnam as a combat medic. He was honorably discharged in 1971.

Mike earned his Bachelor of Science in business and accounting from the University of Wisconsin-Parkside. He has served on the board of directors

on the UW-Parkside Foundation, including president from 1998 to 2000, and is now a director emeritus. For his achievements and service, Mr. Falbo was recognized with the UW-Parkside Distinguished Alumni Award in 2021.

Mike is also a graduate of the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He has received two Honorary Doctorate Degrees from the University of Wisconsin-Parkside and University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2021. He has served on the board of directors for many non-profit and community organizations and has been honored for his leadership with awards including the YMCA of Metropolitan Milwaukee Volunteer of the Year Award and the Thurgood Marshall Scholarship Fund Founders Award.

Mike and his wife Sheila have been married for 52 years. They have two married daughters, Stacey and Jessica, and four Grandchildren, Abigail, Oliver Micaela and Madison.
